Jake Laird Law. The law was, dubbed the “Jake Laird Law,” allowing the seizure and retention of firearms from dangerous and mentally ill individuals. It created Chapter, IC 34-47-14, “Proceedings for the Seizure and Retention of a Firearm”.

{¶19} The jury convicted appellant of murder with a firearm specification, and tampering with evidence. The trial court sentenced appellant to prison terms of fifteen years to life for murder, three additional years for the firearm specification, and five years for tampering with evidence, the sentences to be served consecutively.
