The Caribbean island nation of Jamaica was a British colony between 1655 and 1962, these 300 years of English rule changed the face of the island considerably (having previously been under Spanish rule and populated mainly by the indigenous Arawak and Taino communities – now 92.1% of Jamaicans are descended from Sub-Saharan Africans who were brought over as slaves by the British).
