The Production of Japanese Woodblock Prints Introduction The production of classic Japanese woodblock prints is a fairly complex process, involving a number of steps, each usually performed by a different person, one skilled in that particular step.

Production of Japanese Woodblock Prints

Woodblock printing in Japan (???, mokuhanaga) is a technique best known for its use in the ukiyo-e artistic genre of single sheets, but it was also used for printing books in the same period. Woodblock printing had been used in China for centuries to print books, long before the advent of movable type, but was widely adopted in Japan during the Edo period (1603–1868).

Japanese woodblock prints are primarily unique in that for the first time, the woodblock print served not as a reproduction of an already existing work of art. From the beginning of the art of printmaking in Japan in the 17th century, there was an explicit plan by artists to transform printing techniques.
